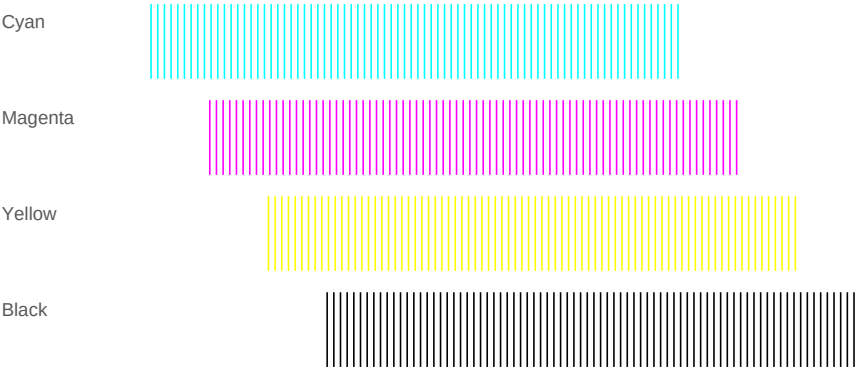


Canon Pixma Printer Test Page

One-sheet diagnostic, laid out the way a Canon nozzle check reads.

Section 1 - Nozzle-Check Staircase



Each stepped row a full set of fine lines. Missing or broken lines mean clogged nozzles.

Section 2 - Streak Bands



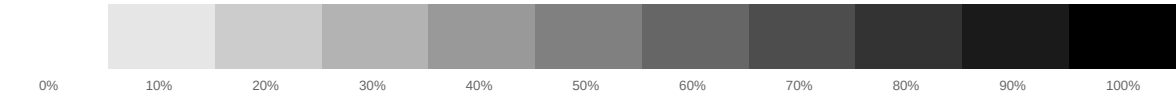
Each band solid and even. Horizontal white streaks are a separate fault - align the head or check the feed.

Section 3 - Color Blocks (C / M / Y / K)



Each block solid and even. A missing block points to an empty tank, not just a clog.

Section 4 - Gray Ramp



Steps should read neutral gray with no color tint. A cast means one channel is off.

Section 5 - Text Sharpness

6pt - The quick brown fox jumps over the lazy dog. 0123456789
