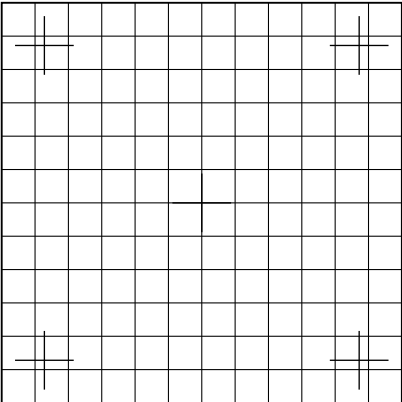


HP Printer Test Page

One-sheet diagnostic. The five zones mirror HP's Print Quality Diagnostic report.

Zone 1 - Alignment



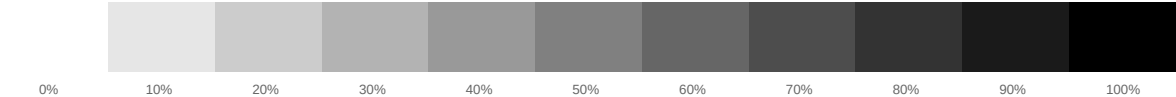
Lines straight and evenly spaced; each crosshair centered. Wavy lines mean realign.

Zone 2 - Color Blocks (C / M / Y / K)



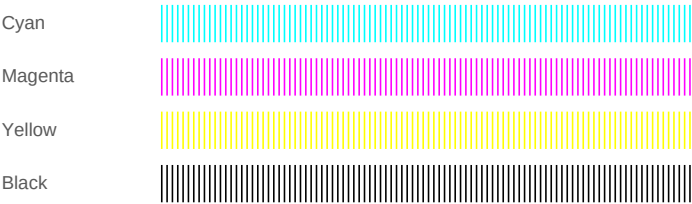
Each block solid and even. White streaks or a missing block mean clean the printhead (or check the cartridge).

Zone 3 - Gray Ramp



Steps should read neutral gray with no color tint. A cast means one channel is off.

Zone 4 - Nozzle Check



Each band a solid field of fine lines, no gaps. Gaps mean blocked nozzles (inkjet only).

Zone 5 - Text Sharpness

6pt - The quick brown fox jumps over the lazy dog. 0123456789
